Vision: Empowering our community by bringing people together.

Aims:

<u>Ensure Sustainability</u>: *Ensure effective governance, operations, and the development of strategic partnerships for ongoing viability.*

Strategies:

- a) Create new financial streams, including corporate sponsorship.
- b) Implement management restructure and increase human resources.
- c) Increase online presence and promotional efforts via new website and other platforms.
 - d) Improve equipment, aesthetic, and amenities.
 - e) Secure long term, recurrent funding agreement with DoC.

<u>Embrace Diversity</u>: Provide opportunities for specific groups within the locality to participate in our service, and tailor programming to emerging community needs.

- a) Implement a program for socially isolated seniors focused on digital education, including CALD Seniors.
- b) Implement a new empowerment program for women focused on skill development, knowledge sharing and networking.
 - c) Implement VIBE a new recreation, education, and social program for youth.
- d) Implement KM Earth Care Initiatives creating a central and accessible point of connection and exchange for social movements focused on the environment and sustainability.

<u>Strengthen Collaboration:</u> Increase inter-agency collaboration to optimise service provision and to extend our community reach.

- a) Proactively invite non-profits to run workshops from KMCC.
- b) Explore ways in which for-profit businesses can operate from KMCC.
- c) Extend joint service provision either at KMCC or in the community with organisations such StudentEdge; Westside Gym, & Zonta House Refuge Association.
